We have had a busy two months since the start of the new year.

During the months of March and April, we will have a busy schedule which includes a Past Masters Night and 3rd Degree, a 2nd Degree, and a Lodge Camping Trip.

On Saturday, March 11th, we will raise Bro. Shamoun to the 3rd Degree of Freemasonry. This event will be done by the Past Masters of our Lodge, along with

Past Masters from all over Southern California.

On Wednesday, April 12^{th} , we will pass Bro. Rios-Otero to the 2^{nd} Degree of Freemasonry.

In an attempt to bring new activities to the Lodge over the weekend of April 21-23, L.A. Harbor Lodge will be heading to the Black Mountain Wilderness near Barstow, and northeast of the town of Hinkley (made famous from the movie Erin Brockovich) for a weekend camping trip.

Black Mountain stands at 3,941 feet, a mesa rising above an expanse of desolate, ancient lava flows. The mountain lies in the northwest corner of the Wilderness, and from the summit, the area drops in elevation to 2,080 feet. We will be camping on the valley floor, in or near a dry lake, which does not have a name, but it's unofficially called 'Lost Lake' or 'Lost Grandfather Lake.'

The cost is \$20 per person for breakfast and dinner. We are asking that all participants cover the cost of their own gas, daily lunch, and other supplies, and to pitch in on gas or supplies with whomever they are riding with. Such a man has found the only real secret of Masonry, and the one which he is trying to give to all the world."
