



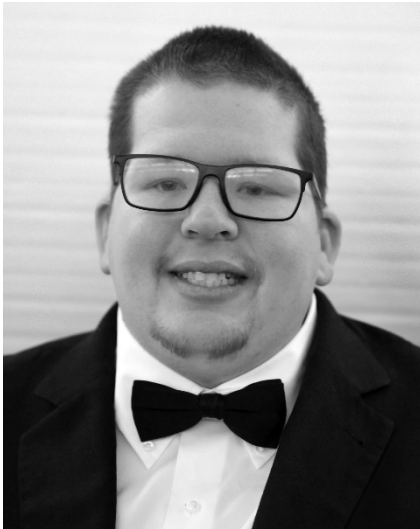
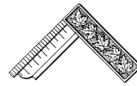

Ahoy Brethren,

We have had a busy two months since the start of the new year.

On January 25th, we passed Bro. Shamoun to the 2nd Degree of Freemasonry. The degree was very well attended, and Bro. Shamoun was very pleased with the degree.

During the months of March and April, we will have a busy schedule which includes a Past Masters Night and 3rd Degree, a 2nd Degree, and a Lodge Camping Trip.

On Saturday, March 11th, we will raise Bro. Shamoun to the 3rd Degree of Freemasonry. This event will be done by the Past Masters of our Lodge, along with

Past Masters from all over Southern California.

On Wednesday, April 12th, we will pass Bro. Rios-Otero to the 2nd Degree of Freemasonry.

In an attempt to bring new activities to the Lodge over the weekend of April 21-23, L.A. Harbor Lodge will be heading to the Black Mountain Wilderness near Barstow, and northeast of the town of Hinkley (made famous from the movie Erin Brockovich) for a weekend camping trip.

Black Mountain stands at 3,941 feet, a mesa rising above an expanse of desolate, ancient lava flows. The mountain lies in the northwest corner of the Wilderness, and from the summit, the area drops in elevation to 2,080 feet. We will be camping on the valley floor, in or near a dry lake, which does not have a name, but it's unofficially called 'Lost Lake' or 'Lost Grandfather Lake.'

The cost is \$20 per person for breakfast and dinner. We are asking that all participants cover the cost of their own gas, daily lunch, and other supplies, and to pitch in on gas or supplies with whomever they are riding with. Additional information can be found by contacting Wor. Andrew Perry, who is the chairman of this activity.

WHEN IS A MAN A MASON?

M.W. Brother General Charles Fergusson, in an address many years ago before the Grand Lodge of New Zealand, answered the question, "When is a man a Mason?," in this way:

“When he can look out over the rivers and hills and the far horizon with a profound sense of his own littleness in the vast scheme of things and yet have faith, hope, and courage, which is the root of every virtue.

When he knows that down in his heart every man is as noble, as vile, as divine, and diabolic, and as lonely as himself, and seeks to know, to forgive, and to love his fellowman. When he knows how to sympathize with men in their sorrows, yea, even in their sins, knowing that each man fights a hard fight

When he can be happy and high-minded amid the meaner drudgeries of life. When no voice of distress reaches his ears in vain, and no hand seeks his aid without response. When he can look into a wayside puddle and see something beyond mud, and into the face of the most forlorn fellow mortal and see something beyond sin.

When he knows how to pray, how to love, how to hope. When he has kept faith with himself, with his fellowman, with his God; in his hand a sword for evil, in his heart a bit of a song – glad to live and not afraid to die!

Such a man has found the only real secret of Masonry, and the one which he is trying to give to all the world."

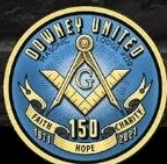
