



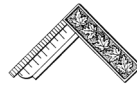

**FOR REFLECTION**

**THE SANCTUARY OF TRUTH**

“Who are we? Where are we from? How do we live our lives? And what is a life goal?” These are some of the most common philosophical questions which have been asked several times. Any answer from any time will not be the same...and so it is in these times.

Five years ago I had the opportunity to visit a place called *The Sanctuary of Truth* in Thailand. I had heard about how remarkable the place was but was unsure of what I might find there. The name itself piqued my interest. What might I find there?

Simply put, it is an amazing place! *The Sanctuary of Truth* was begun as a private devotion to Thai culture and religion by just one man and his wife. No government money goes to this beautiful project. It's all completely carved in wood – by hand – and is the largest carved wooden building in the world.

It's neither a temple nor residence, nor will it become one. It was begun in 1981, and work continues today. It's about 75% complete and they expect that it will take another 20 years to finish. There are 170 columns supporting the structure, but not all of them are completed. At the time I visited, there were about 6 workers carving inside the sanctuary and another two dozen artists working in the nearby workshop. The “Trestleboard” is a 3-D mock up in a much smaller scale of about 100:1 or so.

We had a private tour. The takeaway is that they want you to understand the meaning and duties of life: service, sacrifice, respect, and learning, among others. We come into this life with nothing, and we leave with nothing. By utilizing these duties of life, you can make life better; but we are cautioned to destroy greed, deceit, selfishness, and hate because they further nothing.

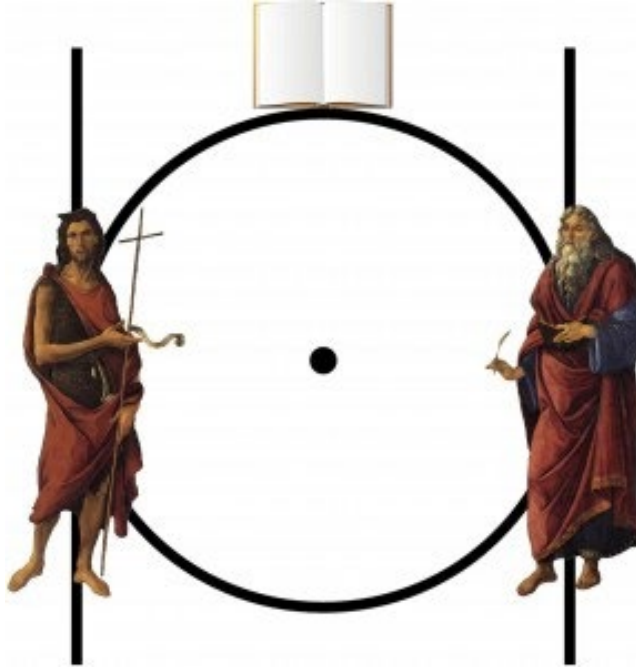
